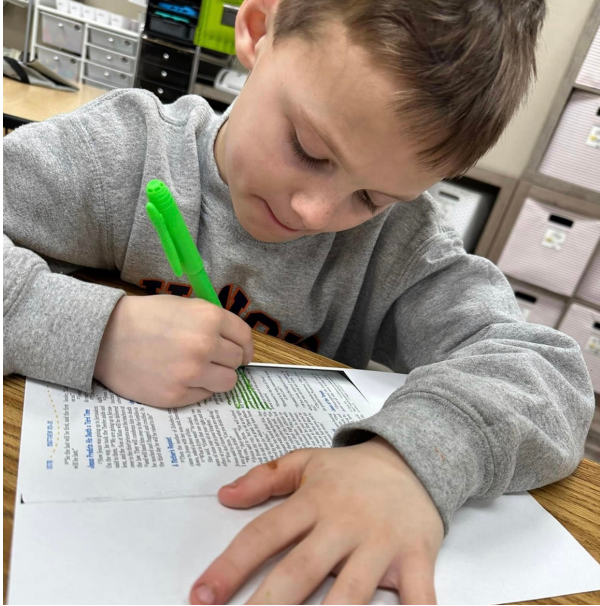
## BLASTING OUT OF FIRST GRADE
