REGISTRATION: Current families must register for camp by **April 14th** in order to reserve a spot. Enrollment will be limited and will be open to the public on April 17th if space allows. Please submit a copy of most recent school physical.

NOTE: Summer camp ends on August 4. You must find alternate care for your child after this date.

WHAT TO WEAR: Students should wear comfortable clothing each day. Sandals are okay, but it is recommended to pack a pair of tennis shoes for outdoor play.

WHAT TO BRING: Water bottle, sunscreen (no spray sunscreen please), swimsuit, towel, and a change of clothes. All items should be labeled with the child’s name and kept in a small bag that is transported to and from camp each day.

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME: The Summer Camp teachers will keep the students involved in activities throughout the day. Toys may be brought but they will need to stay in their cubby or bag until they are allowed to take them out. LH&H will not be responsible for any personal belongings that are lost.

CAMP INFO: Our Summer Camp Director is Chaney Reifsteck. She is the 1st grade teacher here at LH&H and has been running summer camp for the past 8 years.

Summer Camp will be filled with fun themes, games, crafts, science experiments, food and field trips each week! We promise to provide a safe environment where the kids are encouraged to try new things and meet new friends. At LH&H our top priority is to teach the importance of kindness, incorporate God into our daily tasks, and have FUN!

HOW DOES SUMMER CAMP WORK: Your child will be placed in a summer camp group according to their age. There will be 5 groups that we will post before camp begins. Each group will have a set room and Facebook group where they will post their field trips and activities for each week. Each group will have set teachers along with part-time assistants and Ms. Chaney will be overseeing all of the rooms and activities.

POOL/WATERPLAY INFO: Only the oldest group will go to the Urbana pool, more details to come as we get into summer.

Waterplay: We will do waterplay every day from 1:00-2:45 unless it is storming. Waterplay will include small pools, waterslides, slip-n-slides, sprinklers, water guns, water balloons and more. Please make sure they have their swim items and sunscreen EVERYDAY. We will wash suits on Wednesdays. **On FRIDAYS**, the swimsuits and towels will be sent home to be washed.
