REGISTRATION: Current SCA students must apply for camp by April 12th in order to reserve a spot. Enrollment will be limited and will be open to the public on April 15th as space allows. Please submit a copy of the most recent school physical with the online form. The SCA Summer Camp application can be accessed through your **FACTS Family Portal**.

Summer camp ends on August 2. You must find alternate care for your child after this date.

We will wash suits on Wednesdays. On FRIDAYS, the swimsuits and towels will be sent home to be washed.
